

Recycling Reminders

Paper & Cardboard Recycling

- remove all liners
- flatten all boxes
- remove plastic from cardboard flats

Container Recycling

- empty & rinse containers
 - labels are okay
- remove caps, pumps & lids
 - place loose in the bin
- put metal lids inside cans & squeeze slightly
- take deposit containers to Return-It Depot for refund

What to recycle

Items marked with a ✓ are acceptable in the curbside recycling carts and at recycling depots.
Items marked in ✗ should be placed in the garbage.

Paper Cups & Lids

- ✓ All disposable paper based cups & lids



- ✗ Straws

Cartons (plastic coated)

- ✓ Rinsed milk / milk alternative cartons
- ✓ Rinsed soup 'tetra-pak' containers



- ✗ Straws
- ✗ Stand-up drink pouches

Aerosol Cans & Cups

- ✓ Hairspray, deodorant, shaving cream, air freshener, food based aerosols
- ✓ Cans must be completely empty



- ✗ Spray paint cans (take to hazardous waste depot)
- ✗ Propane cylinders (please call for recycling options)

Plastic Containers & Lids

- ✓ All empty & rinsed household plastic containers with the #1 - 7 recycling symbols



- ✗ Lawn edging, tarps, plastic furniture or toys or garden hoses
- ✗ Motor oil or chemical containers (visit www.usedoilrecycling.com for drop off locations)
- ✗ Plastic bags & styrofoam must be taken to depot only.

Spiral Wound Paper Cans & Lids

- ✓ Frozen juice, coffee cans, nuts, chips, baby formula cans.
- ✓ Put lids in the cart loose



Microwaveable Paper Containers

- ✓ Single serve soups & other paper bowls

- ✗ Bowls with metal rims

Aluminum

- ✓ Foil & Food containers
- ✓ Empty & Rinse
- ✓ Labels are ok

- ✗ Chip or foil bags
- ✗ Foil wrap from butter or cigarettes

Tin Cans & Lids

- ✓ All tin cans, keep lids attached
- ✓ Empty & Rinse
- ✓ Labels are ok



- ✗ Coat hangers, pots, pans or baking trays (please donate or take to metal recycling)

Paper & Magazines

- ✓ Newspaper, flyers & inserts
- ✓ White/coloured paper & magazines, catalogues, phone books
- ✓ Paper pet food bags (not foil lined)
- ✓ Shredded paper accepted inside CLEAR plastic bag

- ✗ Carbon paper, used tissue or paper towels, foil gift wrap, ribbons, bows, padded envelopes
- ✗ Books (please donate)

Cardboard & Boxboard

- ✓ Clean cardboard boxes, pizza boxes, etc.
- ✓ Cereal box-type cardboard



- ✗ Waxed produce boxes

Frozen Food Packaging

- ✓ Rinsed, plastic coated boxes such as ice cream cartons

Depot only items

Items below marked with a ✓ are acceptable at recycling depots only.
Items marked with an ✗ should be placed in the garbage.

Glass

- ✓ Clear or coloured glass jars

- ✗ Glasses, dishes, cookware, window glass or mirrors
- ✗ Ceramics
- ✗ Take a beverage glass back to depot for deposit or refund

Styrofoam

- ✓ Clean meat trays, foam egg cartons, take out containers, cups & bowls
- ✓ Cushion packaging

- ✗ Foam peanuts, packing chips, noodles
- ✗ Blue or pink foam board insulation
- ✗ Shrink wrap for meats

Plastic Bags & Overwrap

- ✓ Bags for groceries, dry cleaning, bread, salad, frozen vegetable bags, outer bags for diaper, soft drinks, overwrap on mattresses, furniture & electronics

- ✗ Cellophane wrap, stretch or cling wrap
- ✗ Biodegradable or composite plastic bags, Zipper-lock bags
- ✗ Potato chip or snack bags
- ✗ Bubble wrap, Plastic shipping envelopes
